## *Deilephila elpenor*

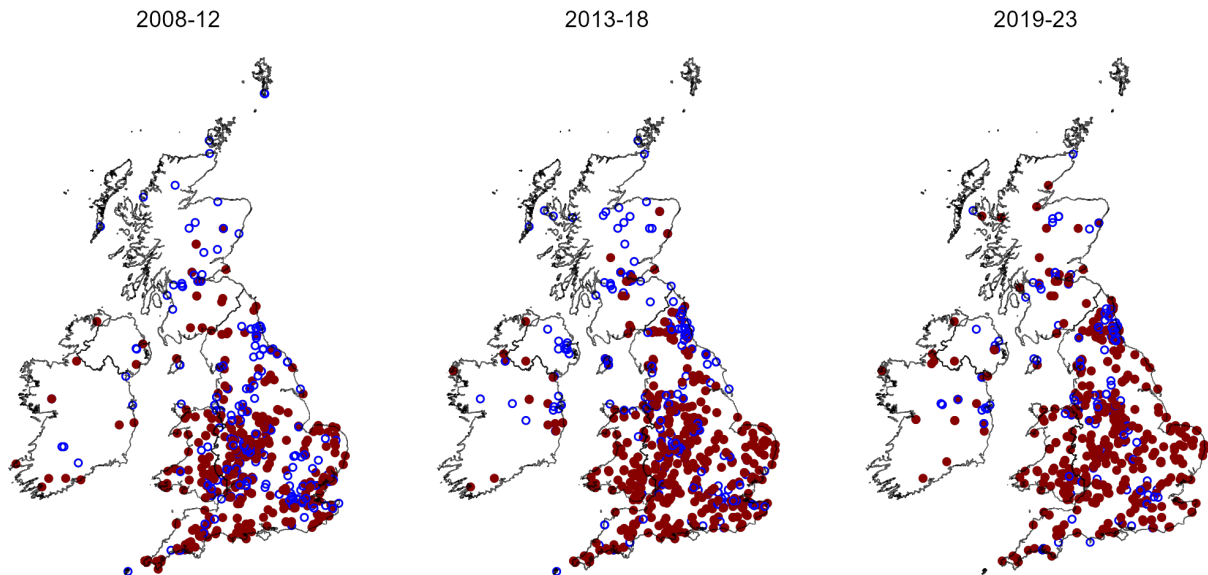
A common and widespread species.

Range has increased markedly since 1970.

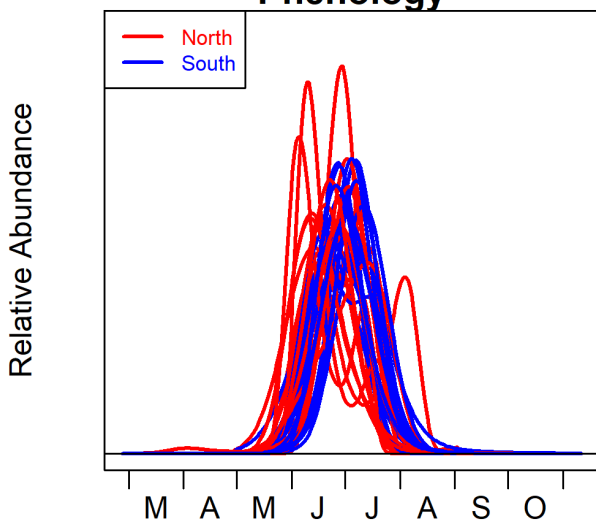
Increasing GMS abundance nationally, with a more rapid increase in the North compared to the South. This may be a species that is doing particularly well in gardens compared to the wider countryside as RIS data shows no recent increase.
