

# 73.250: Twin-spotted Quaker

## *Anorthoa munda*

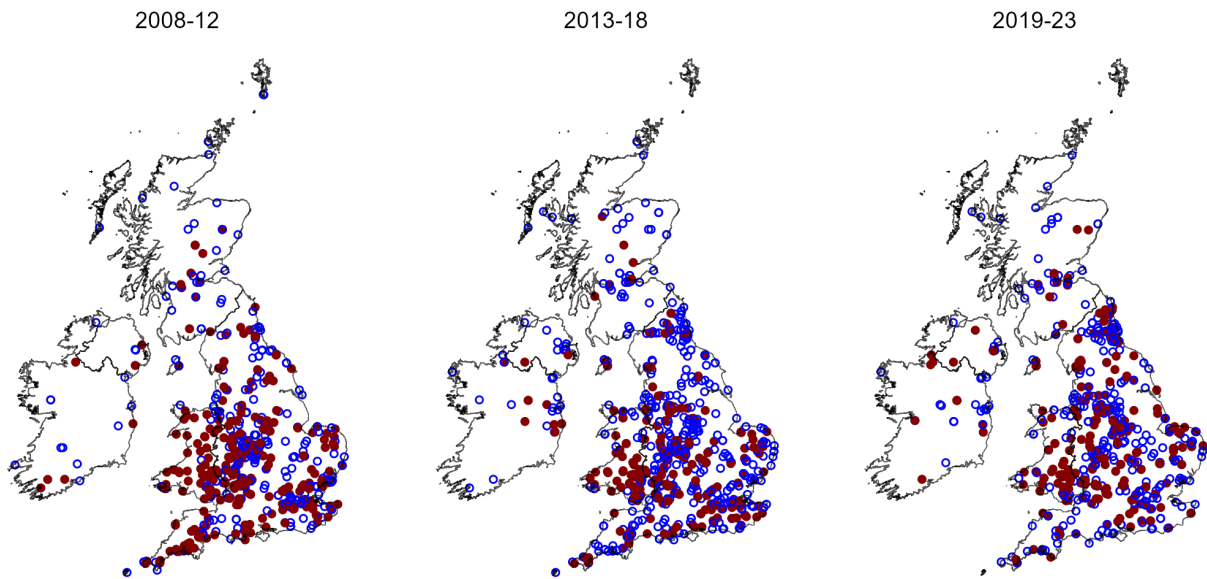
A common early season species with a regional (westerly) distribution.

Has increased range since 1970 spreading in Scotland. Now flies earlier.

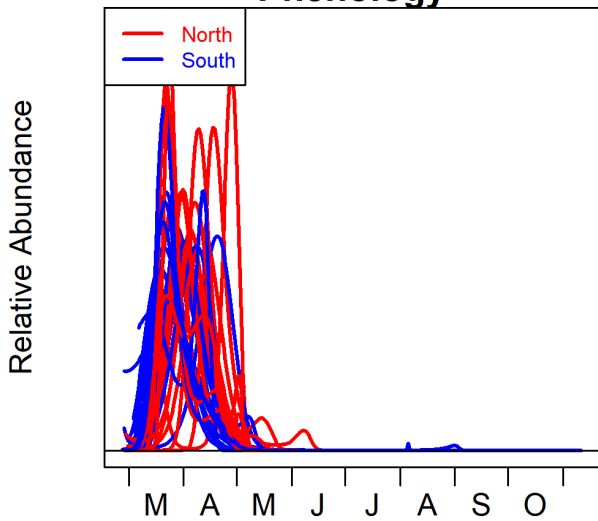
Significant decline in GMS abundance in the South but not in the North. Some evidence of loss of range in the south.
