A very common species, widespread except in Scotland and the west. Double-brooded.

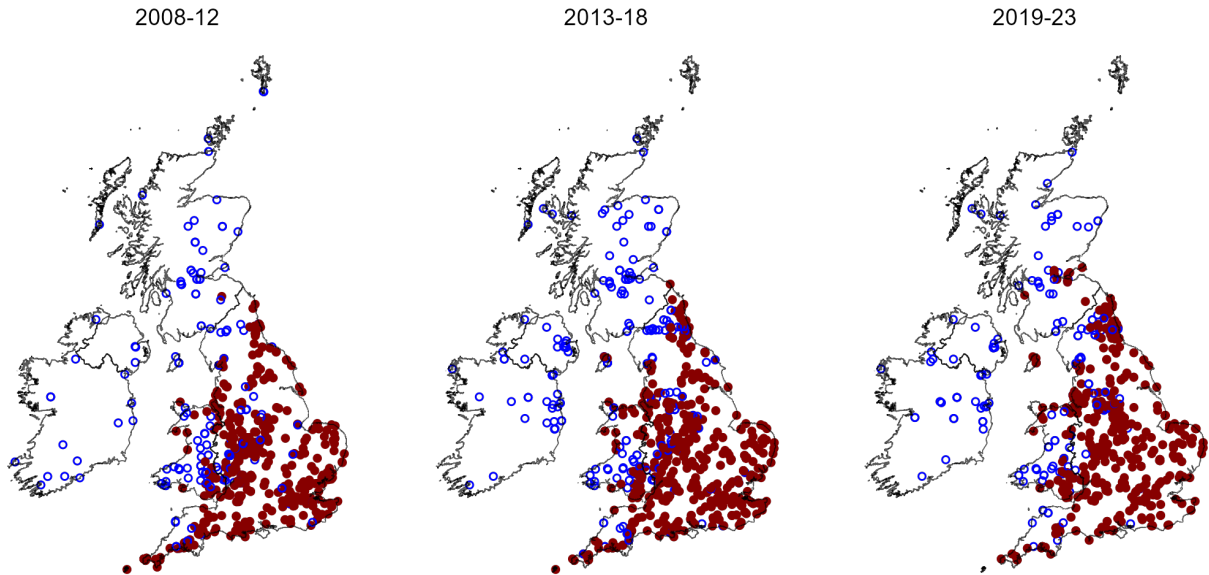
Has increased in range since 1970.

GNS abundance has increased in the North with little change in the South. Some increase in range into Scotland.

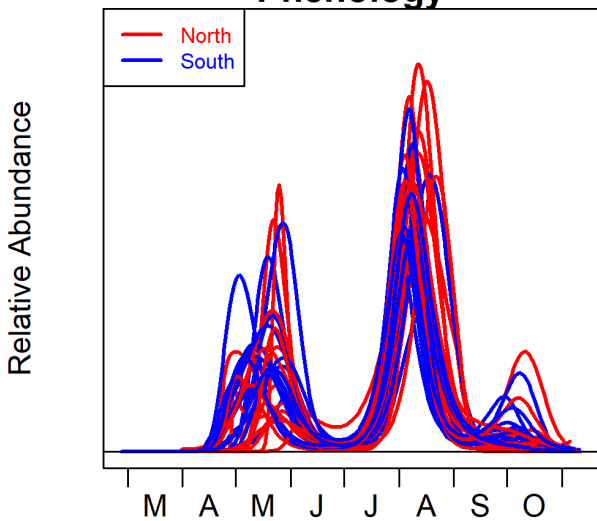
Some evidence for a partial third brood in some years
